Main Gallery

Our main exhibition space is 11.9 x 10m with a ceiling height of 4.3m. The gallery walls are MDF and the floors are concrete. This space has adjustable track lighting and ceiling level windows that are blacked out.

Projector Room

This intimate space can be used as second exhibition space or is suitable for video projection. It measures 11.9 x 3.8m with a ceiling height of 2.5m. The walls are MDF and the floors are concrete. Infrastructure for projectors and speakers are already installed to project on both walls. Overhead fluoro lighting only.

Small Gallery

At the rear of the main gallery is a smaller gallery space. This space is 6.6 x 3m with a ceiling height of 2.5m. The gallery walls are MDF and the floors are concrete. This space has adjustable track lighting.
